The Climb

Monsal hill climb is 675 yards/600m with a gradient of 1 in 6, suitable for fixed gear.

Some describe the climb as a sprinters climb. The start is pretty much flat for the first 150 yards but soon starts to climb once you pass the drive way on your right. All then goes quiet for while until you can hear the roar of the crowd. Once you pass the road sign on your left the lactic kicks in and from there till the end is a non stop effort to the line which is right outside the Monsal Head Hotel and Hobbs Café.



Event Directions. HQ – Monsal Head

The event is situated at Monsal Head, Great Longstone, Nr Bakewell, Derbyshire. Follow the A6 from Bakewell towards Buxton, turn right at Ashford in the Water onto the A6020, proceed 200 yards and turn left onto the B6465. Turn first right in Ashford and proceed for approx 3 miles towards Little Longstone / Wardlow.

Parking

In order to keep traffic flowing on the day, all competitors and spectators are encouraged to park in the field just outside Little Longstone. This will be clearly signed posted. There is a charge of just £2.00 and it is cash only. All funds raised will be donated to the Little Longstone Parish Church. Over the years we have raised thousands of pounds and this really does help us maintain a good relationship with the local residents. Once parked, please leave via the gate you entered and don't climb over any of the stone walls as they are very fragile.

The car park at the top of Monsal Head is only available for officials and traders. Access will only be granted via an official pass.

Please don't park on the main road from Ashford to Wardlow as that is the diversion route and we would like to keep this as clear as possible during the event.

Signing On

Signing on opens at 9:30am and is situated at the top of the climb. All riders must sign on, collect a body number, arm number and pins. Please allow enough time to arrive, park and walk up to sign on. We don't close signing on so it's up to individual riders to allow enough time before their run. All under 18's must bring a completed Parental Consent Form with them.

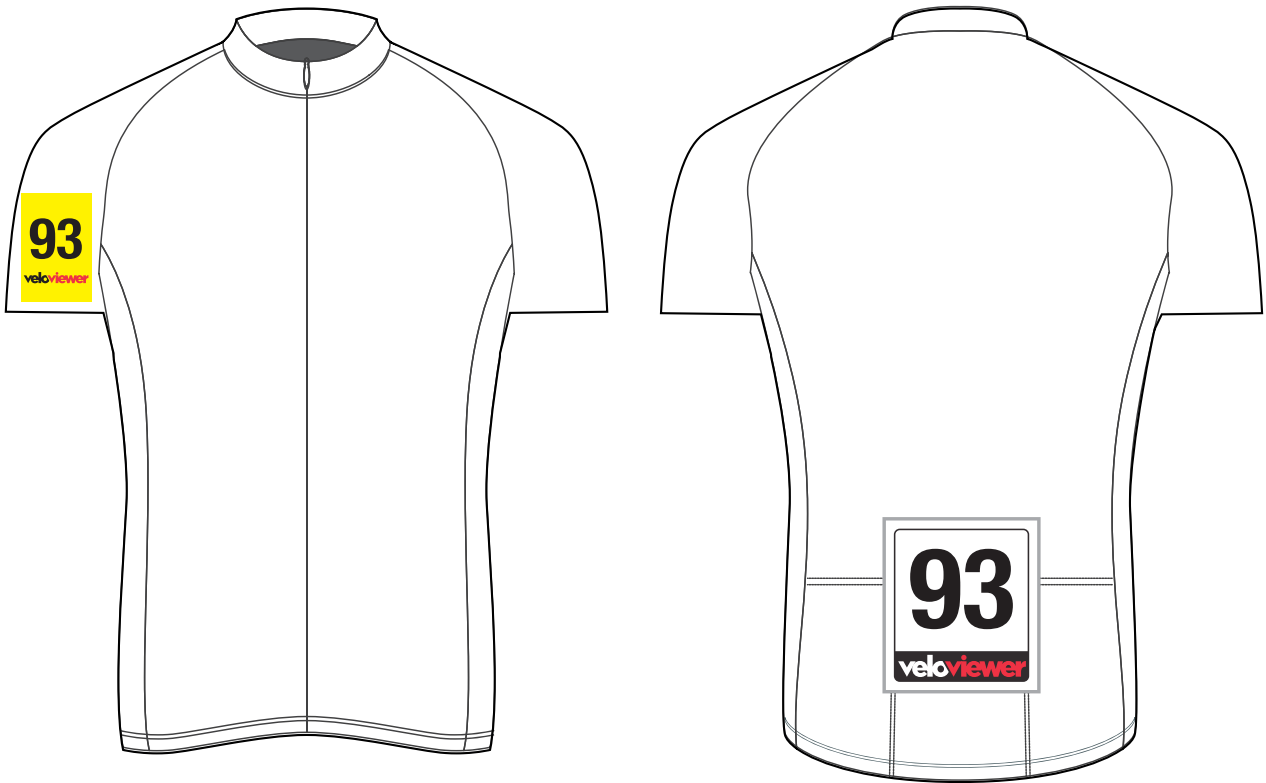
Signing Out

All riders must sign out after their run. This is a strict CTT rule. **Any riders that fail to sign out will be disqualified from the event.** This event could be subject to a random UK Anti Doping test.



Race numbers

You will be issued with 2 non-returnable race numbers. One is for the rear of your jersey and one is for your right hand upper arm, as shown in the diagram below:



Rider Safety

CTT regulations state that hard shell helmets are now compulsory for everyone, so please wear one at all times. Working front and rear lights are also compulsory for all riders. Please make sure that you have one on your bike before you start. The timekeepers will decline you at the start if you don't have a helmet and two working lights.

At the top of the climb, we will have a team of catchers to ensure that you finish your run safely.

Often riders do collapse once over the finish line and the one before you may be laid in your path, so please take instructions from them at the top of the climb. They are there to make sure that the whole area is safe for you finish and recover from your heroic effort.

First Aid

The First Aid point will be in the Monsal Head Hotel Stables Bar. This is behind Hobbs Café, opposite signing on. Our Medical team will be on site from 10:30am until the conclusion of the event. The nearest hospitals are in Sheffield (Northern General Hospital) or Chesterfield (Chesterfield Royal Hospital).

Getting to the Start Line

We allow riders to descend down Monsal Head to the start. This is managed by marshals so please await their instructions when heading to the start. Once you have been given permission to drop down the climb, please be aware that after the closed barrier section, spectators will be on the course watching riders coming up the climb, potentially with their back to you so please keep your speed to a minimum and if you do see another rider coming up the climb, please pull to one side and if needed stop to allow them a clear run. The road is closed to traffic but if you do see a car on the route, it will have been given permission for access. There is a private house and a fishing club car park on route which we need to allow access to during the event. For the duration of the event, the road will allow access for emergency vehicles. Please do not cross the start line once you are the bottom of the climb or make any U turns in sight of the start.

If you leave any clothing at the start it will be returned to signing on at the end of the event. Please remember to collect before you head home.

Your Start Time

All riders are allocated a time slot which corresponds with your race number and timing chip. All riders start at 1 minute intervals and should be at the start in plenty of time to line up in order. At 30 seconds, you'll be called to the start line and held by our team of helpers. You'll receive a countdown before you are allowed to start. If for any reason you miss your start time, you will receive a time penalty. If there is a start time free, the timekeepers will allow you to start late with the penalty applied to your overall time. **It is your responsibility to be at the start on time.**

Warming Up

Most riders use rollers and turbo trainers but you can warm up on roads around the area. Please don't warm up on the diversion route of Haydale as we want to try and keep this free for local traffic to travel towards Cressbrook. The climb will be closed from 9:30am and will be open to use for warming up from 9:45am and course familiarisation until 10:45am. Please do not warm up on the course once the event starts at 11:01am.

Refreshments

There will be hot drinks and food available from the Monsal Head Hotel and Hobb's Cafe. Please support them.

Toilets

There are toilets just behind the Monsal Head Hotel.

Results

Times will be posted at the signing on area on boards. We will be using CTT live results on the day. A QR code will be available to scan and view on race day.

We will publish provisional results on the event website as soon as possible after the event and submit to CTT a few days after. If you have any queries, please let us know asap.

Prize Presentations

There will be a prize presentation around 25 minutes after the last rider has finished their run at the top of the climb. The top 3 in all categories will be called forward and presented with their prize in line with the published prize list. If you think you are in the top 3, please stay for the presentation. Spot prize vouchers will be sent out via post after the event.

If you miss your prize presentation, we'll contact you after the event to arrange collection.

Trophies

All trophies are to be kept for 12 months and must be returned after this period. We are happy for you to engrave them. If you do arrange to engrave them, save your receipt and we will gladly re-inburse you.

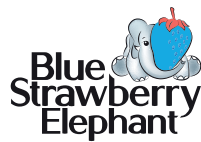
